## PROGRAM NOTES

### Topic & Speaker: **Economic Development- Bob Repine**

- Bob shared a trip to South Korea with about 50 people from Oregon including Governor Ted.
- He shared what their culture is like & their traditional ways like seating arrangements at meals & meetings. They seat in order based on rank & power. They then seat our people next to theirs matching the same rank.
- Even their dress code has rules and customs. Our group from Oregon made an effort to wear black & blue, nice suits, but with darker & solid colors. They stayed away from bright colors and/or bright & fun ties in order to not offend the Korean members or embarrass our Governor. Our group from Oregon went to an orientation on these customs & traditions on behalf of the Korians to honor their ways. ☺
- Bob shared with our club many slide show pictures!
- We learned that the Hynex Company that makes silk & wafers is a large company in Eugene and they employ about 1200 people. They had a press conference in Korea with this group. It went well! ☺
- The cost of living is very high in Korea! One lunch cost about \$1400.00 to feed about a dozen people. The meal was about \$68.00 a head not including beverages & desert.
- We saw a picture or two that showed Commissioner/Judge Scott

- Cooper at one of the meetings whom is from Prineville, Oregon.
- Bob also shared a train ride that was very solid on the tracks and traveling at 188 miles/per hour. Bob did have a bit of concern when they obtained all of the Oregonians Pass Ports & held them during this time of the agenda & kept all of them all in isolation & provided escorting. They just had to completely trust at that point. ☺
- This trip cost Oregon about \$110,000, but truly was money well spent for the meetings, negotiations and commitments went so well and will bring jobs to Oregon and a few million dollars!! ☺
